OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

To ensure the safe operation of ProBasics® Canes, these instructions must be followed.

PROPER CANE HEIGHT

- Stand as upright as possible on a firm, flat surface and let your arm hang down naturally by your side.
- Adjust cane so top portion of handle touches inside of wrist where it meets palm.

NOTE: For a more comfortable fit, ensure shoe height is the same as shoe style worn most frequently when using cane.

HEIGHT ADJUSTMENT

- 1. Loosen the locking ring by twisting clockwise.
- 2. Adjust the cane height by depressing the brass push button and sliding the lower section upward or downward to desired height.

NOTE: An audible click will be heard when push button securely protrudes through the adjustment hole.

- 3. Repeat steps 1-2 until cane is at proper height.
- 4. Tighten locking ring by turning counter-clockwise.

MAINTENANCE

- Ensure the snap button releases and re-engages properly.
- 2. Inspect cane tips for wear and damage.
- 3. Replace any broken, damaged or worn items immediately.

WARNINGS

DO NOT ATTEMPT TO ADJUST OR OPERATE CANE WITHOUT READING ALL INSTRUCTIONS CAREFULLY.

- The cane is intended to be used solely as a walking aid and all other use can cause risk of injury.
- This product has a maximum user weight limitation of 300 LB/136 KG (CNOFBK, CNOFBZ, CNOFSL), 500 lb/227 kg (CNOFHD). Canes are **NOT** designed to support the total weight of individuals.
- Before use, ensure cane tip is properly seated and straight.
 Check rubber tip for rips, tears, cracks or wear. If any of these conditions exist, replace rubber tip immediately.
- Before use, the height adjustment push button MUST be fully engaged and protruding through height adjustment hole on cane to ensure a positive lock. ALWAYS test to see that cane handle is properly and securely locked in place or a fall could result, causing bodily injury and/or damage to the cane.
- Make sure locking ring is securely tightened at all times.
- This cane is **NOT** intended for use on stairs.
- Avoid wet floors, ice, soft ground and similar hazards.
- If components are damaged or missing, contact your dealer immediately. DO NOT use substitute parts.
- Failure to follow these instructions may result in serious injury.
